

October 4, 2008 Lost Lake Fishing Club Minutes

President Stoksdale opened the meeting at 8:30. Frank Holder had the 50/50 drawing which netted the club \$20. Ron Berger gave the treasurers report. As of today the balance in the club is \$1,348.60. Robert Stoksdale reported on the cans, and that it is still cost effective to collect cans for the club. He also reported on the fishing contest and picnic in September. "Everything went well and everyone seemed to have a good time".

Joe Olliges reported on the recent stocking program by the RCD. There were 88 muskie at 10-12 inches, and 880 Walleye at about 8 inches. There were also 880 Small Mouth Bass stocked. The entire project costs about \$4300.

Joe also reported that due to budget problems with the DNR, that there would be no fish survey done this year.

Frank Durkin gave a report on the Lily Pads that were put in the lake. Turtles or beaver decimated the flowers. We will continue to try to catch Beaver and Muskrats. The next attempt to grow some vegetation will include some type of fencing to keep fish, turtles, and beaver away from the plants.

The ice-fishing derby in February was discussed. Dave Strasemeier will head up the years event. Anyone wanting to enter the Chili cook off needs to contact Dave Strasemeier.

The fishing club sign is finished, and we should use it to remind people of the next meeting in November.
